

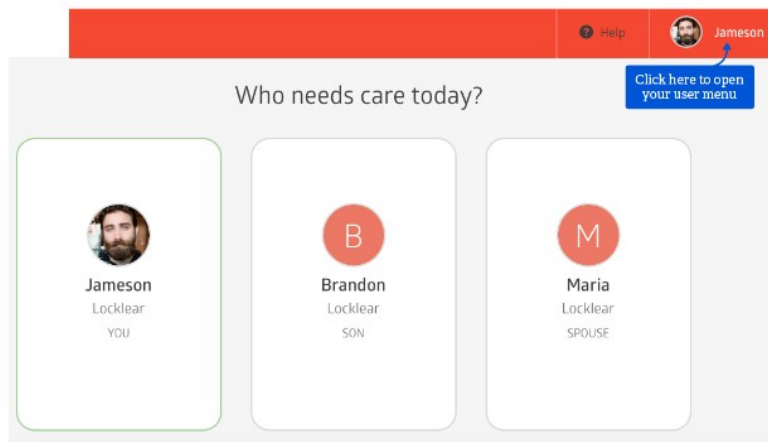
HOW TO ADD A DEPENDENT TO YOUR SNAPMD ACCOUNT 2020

1. If your child is less than 13 years old, then you have to register for an account and add each child as a dependent. Also if English is not your primary language click on the icon to change it.

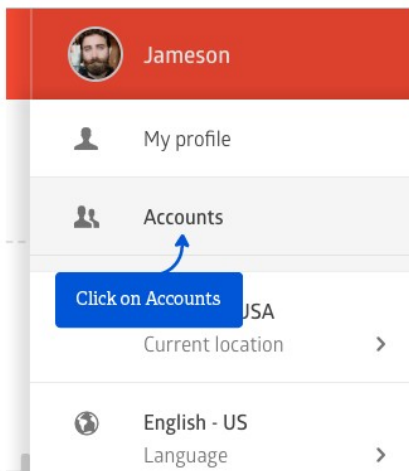
Add a Dependent

On the right side click on your name to see the **User Menu**



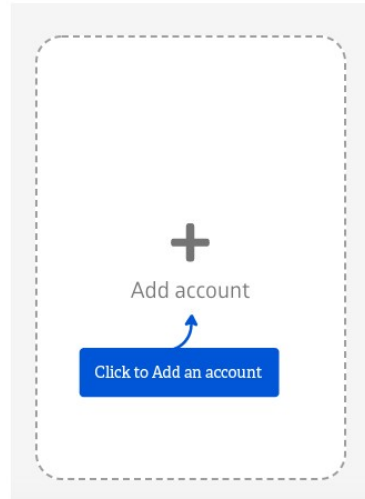
Click on **Accounts**



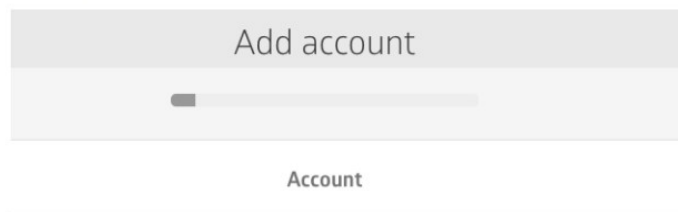
